This eight-session continuum teaches the principles of managing patients with TMD symptoms related to occlusion disharmony. Importance is placed on identifying the role of ascending and descending components on postural and occlusal symptoms. Participants will learn to determine goals of patient treatment, optimum treatment planning, and restorative management.

The objectives of this course are for the participant to be able to:

- Perform a complete intraoral and extraoral exam, and complete a comprehensive medical history to document all risk management factors associated with the patient treatment
- Identify TMD Symptoms, and be able to diagnose and treatment plan the patient in pain
- Understand the pathology of pain
- Utilize knowledge of anatomy, bite management and pain management to provide better care for your patient
- Utilize information gained in the course regarding coordinated disciplines (NM Massage, holistic medicine, nutrition orthodontics, implantology chiropractic AO/NUCA) to provide more comprehensive care options for the patient in pain
- Understand the advanced principles of prosthodontics, and pain management to prepare and deliver treatment, including preparation and cementation for full mouth reconstruction
- Understand the principles of managing patients with TMD symptoms related to occlusion disharmony
- Identify the role of ascending and descending components on postural and occlusal symptoms
- Manage the dental component of TMD through orthopedic positioning of the mandible and long-term stabilization utilizing principles taught in LVI restorative courses
- Identify or understand restorative concepts and apply them as appropriate for restoration of the patients dentition
