Frequently Asked Questions

What is the weather like in Bryan, TX?

In the winter months temperatures range from 60-70°. In spring the weather is nice with highs between 70-80°. Summer months are hot, highs up to 95°, with extremely high humidity. In the fall it cools down with temperatures back around 70-80 degrees.

What should I wear when I come to Dr. Reece's Office?
